Side Gate – From Monday 15th September, the side gate (closest to Oakmount Road) will reopen. Please be aware there is a crack along the pavement which may be a trip hazard however this has been clearly cordoned off, please be mindful if you are coming into school this way. We will continue to monitor this on a daily basis.

Menus – Please check our website for our Autumn 1 school menus.

OPAL (Outdoor Play and Learning) – thank you for those parents that have dropped off donations to help us on our OPAL journey. If you have anything that we could use, please bring to the school office.

As mentioned on the last newsletter of the summer term, as part of OPAL children will be playing outside on the field in all weathers. Therefore, all children need:

- A pair of wellies (named) – these can be kept in school
- A waterproof coat

If you have any coats or wellies that your children have grown out of, please consider donating them to the school so they can be used as spares.

PE Kits – Junior children will need to have their PE kits in school on all days. This includes:

- White t-shirt (**not the polo shirt the children wear through the school day**)
- Black shorts and/or joggers
- Black or Green logo-free jumper (**please no hoodies**)
- Trainers
- Spare socks & pants

Absence, Holidays & Attendance – The school is unable to approve any leave for holidays/day trips/time off etc. These missed sessions will be recorded as unauthorised. Children arriving any time after 9:10am in the Juniors and 9:15am in the Infants due to lateness, will automatically be marked as late - unauthorised absence for the entire morning session.

If your child cannot make it into school due to illness or a medical appointment you must contact the school office by 9.15am. You can do this by calling the school number and selecting option 1 to leave a message or by emailing absence@fryern.net Please state your child's name, class and reason for absence.

Contact Details - Please can you notify us as soon as possible if any of your contact details change. You can amend your phone number and email address directly on Arbor, but you will need to contact the school office directly to change your home address, if a change of address is required, please bring in proof of the new address. This is not only to make sure you receive important information, but also to ensure we can contact you in an emergency. Children should have three emergency contacts.

Collecting your child during the school day - If your child needs to attend an appointment during the school day, evidence of the appointment/s should be provided to the school office prior to the appointment. In order to minimise impact on your children's learning, parents/carers should ensure that routine appointments e.g. to see the dentist or doctor, are made during the school holidays or after school wherever possible. Please allow enough time to arrive at the school office so that a member of staff can call for/collect your child from class and sign them out. Your child must be accompanied by an adult when being collected and returned back to school.

Named Items – Please can we remind you to label all children's uniform, water bottle and lunch boxes. This makes it easier for items to be returned to children. Every term we are inundated with unnamed items that are unable to find their way home. Our Lost Property boxes can be located in the reception area.

Snacks and Drinks - A polite reminder to please make sure your child comes to school with a healthy snack and plenty of water. Ideally this should be a piece of fruit or vegetables and should not be crisps, cakes or biscuits. Please also note that children are not allowed squash or any other sugary drink.

Nut Free School - We would like to remind you that our school is strictly nut-free due to the presence of several students with severe, potentially life-threatening nut allergies. This includes all tree nuts such as almonds, cashews, pistachios, and importantly, hazelnut spreads like Nutella. Please check carefully when you are packing your child's lunch. Thank you for your understanding.

Unwanted Uniform - If you have any unwanted school uniform, which is in a good condition, the PTA have a blue bin just outside the front of the school office. The uniform will then be recycled by the PTA for other students.
