## **Important Information & Reminders**

**School Shoes –** Please can we ask that the children's names are clearly written in their school shoes. Many of the children have the same pair and the children are having great difficulty in identifying their own school shoes when changing in and out of their welly boots – which they do daily. We currently have a pair of unnamed, black leather trainer-style size 10 shoes in the school office – if you think these belong to your child, please come to the school office to collect them.

**Warm Clothes -** A polite reminder that as the cold weather has arrived, please can all children bring in warm, waterproof coats and wellies. The children go outside in all weather conditions, please ensure all belongings are named!

**Christmas Tree Decorations** – Each Year at Fryern, we decorate four Christmas Trees one in each house team's colour. If your child would like to make a decoration this weekend to place on their house colour tree, please name them and bring them into school on **Monday 1st of December.**

### Works include:

- Removing and replacing kerbstones at a lower height
- Resurfacing pavements
- Installing tactile paving at crossing points

Traffic management will involve temporary traffic lights (two-, three-, or four-way) at various sites. Disruption will be minimised, emergency access maintained, and information boards will be displayed.
