Curriculum Information for Parents

Year 2 - Summer Term 2 2023

English

Children will be writing persuasive pieces of writing. They will be exploring a story called 'The Smed's and the Smoo's' (please do not read it if your children haven't already). We will also be developing our understanding of adventurous language and how we can use this within our writing. We will be reading the story 'Orion and the dark' to support this. In guided reading we will be focusing on retrieval of information from the text in order to answer questions.

Maths

Our daily maths sessions and mental maths this half term will include....

Statistics:

- *Make tally charts
- *Tables
- *Block diagrams
- *Draw pictograms (1-1)
- *Interpret pictograms (1-1)
- *Draw pictograms (2, 5, 10)
- *Interpret pictograms (2, 5 and 10)

Position and direction:

- *Language of position
- *Describe movement
- *Describe turns
- *Describe movement and turns
- *Shape patterns with turns

We will also have a big focus on the use of the four operations (addition, subtraction, multiplication and division) and the language associated with them. The children will have problem solving questions whereby they have to think about which of the four operations needs to be used in order to solve the problem.

Our learning during this unit will include....

Science

We will be focusing on continuing our dance in preparation for the dance festival at the beginning of sports day. We will also be developing our athletic skills to prepare for our tournament with local schools and sports day.

History

We will be looking at the life of Tim Peake, Neil Armstrong and Christopher Columbus. We will be looking at their achievements and comparing aspects of life in different periods.

Art

We will be looking at paper sculpture and using this to create space scenes.
