# Curriculum Information for Parents

# <u>Year 4 – Autumn Term 2 2024</u>

# <u>English</u>

During our English and guided reading sessions, we will look at a range of text types including:

- Just So stories
- The story of Tutankhamun
- Letters
- Winter poetry

During guided reading sessions, children will be supported to develop their skills of word reading, fluency, comprehension, inference and selecting and retrieving information.

# <u>Maths</u>

Our daily maths sessions and mental maths this half term will include....

## Subtraction:

Subtracting from 4 digit numbers using column subtraction, involving exchanging Problem solving involving addition and subtraction

## Measurement:

Find the area by counting squares Making shapes with specific areas Comparing areas

# Multiplication and Division:

Multiplying and dividing by 10 and 100 Multiplying by 1 and 0 Dividing by 1 and itself Focus on the 3, 6, 7 and 9 times tables

We will continue to be focussed on times tables, testing, learning and practising. Please make sure they go on TT Rockstars very regularly ready for the government testing in June. Keep up the hard work!

# Spelling

As you are now fully aware, Spelling Shed has really taken off. The children are really enjoying the activities and the games they are playing and their spelling abilities are taking off. Please keep encouraging the children to have a go on a regular basis.

#### Our learning during this unit will include.... History

This term, we are going to be learning about the Romans and the impact that they have had on Britain in the past, as well as the lasting impact now. We will consider what changes the Romans brought and what they have done for us.

### **Geography**

Our main focus this term will be history. However, we will also be looking at maps to consider the movement of the Romans. Children will gain a better understanding of where Italy is in relation to the UK.

### Ar

Our art work will be linked to our work on the Romans. We will be looking at the artwork produced by the Romans and the mosaics used in their buildings. We will then have a go at creating our own mosaics.

# <u>PE</u>

This term, we will have netball. We will practise ball skills, passing and shooting before moving on to play matches. We will also be developing our gymnastic skills using the wall bars.

## RE

Our RE work this term will focus on the symbol of light and how this is linked to advent. We will consider the concept of 'symbol' before thinking about symbols linked to advent and Christianity. We will then think about symbols which are special for us.

#### <u>Spanish</u>

This term, we will be learning more key phrases which might be useful when holidaying in Spanish speaking countries. We will be learning about how to order snacks and how to ask for fruit and vegetables at the market.

#### <u>Science</u>

Our topic this term is digestion. We will be looking at different body parts and how different organs work together to digest our food. We will also be looking at the jobs of different foods in the body and a healthy diet.

### <u>Music</u>

We will continue learning African drums. Our concert is on Thursday 12<sup>th</sup> December at 2.30pm.

## <u>PSHE</u>

Our theme for this half term is respect. We will be looking at how this trait can be shown to people, animals and our environment and the difference it can make in our friendships.

# Computing

This half term we will be focusing on audio production. They will learn how to record, edit and publish their own work.
