What are you looking forward to next year? What are you worried about? What do you want to improve on next year?	Research your favourite poem, write why it is your favorite and perform it for your family. If you can, film it to show the rest of the class. Ask one of the audience to write a comment in your book.	Imagine you are sailing your own boat around the world. Write a captain's log (diary entry) about one day when you were out on the open sea. Include lots of description about the creatures you see and how you feel.	Reflect on your year and create a video for the Year 3s about Year 4 to tell them what to expect and what kinds of things they can look forward to.

Write them down and explain the value of each digit.	Research a food web which includes your favourite animal, draw and label it in your book.	Imagine you have £30 to spend and you have to buy at least 5 items (look in shops or online to find prices) – what would you buy? <i>Extra challenge – can you spend exactly £30?</i>	Re-design a room in your house by drawing a 'bird's eye' plan. Think about the size of the room and of each object and design where to put each one. Try to use realistic sizes.	Times Tables, Times Tables, Times Tables!
I enjoy being creative, painting, drawing and visualising.	Create a picture postcard that represents summer. Use lots of bright colours.	Create a material design using printing. You could use potatoes or sponges to create a unique design. Use the paper to decorate your home learning book.	Look around your garden for signs that summer has arrived. Create a photographic montage or, if you don't have a camera, draw what you can see.	Choose an object to sketch from different angles. For example: flowers in a vase or fruit in a bowl. Use a pencil to create your masterpiece.	Research an artist famous for creating landscapes. Create a fact file about them. Then create your own image of a landscape inspired by your chosen artist.
I enjoy being active and doing hands-on activities.	Make sure you are using electricity carefully in your home? Turn off lights and appliances. Remember to always be safe.	Design and make a summer smoothie. Think about fruit that is in season that you could use to make this a healthy drink.	Design and make a summer salad (please photograph). It must have 4 or more ingredients. Write an instructional text to ensure that other children would be able to make it.	In computing, we have been learning about the use of media. We are going to move on to look at audio production. Can you record an extract from a book or your favourite poem and apply different audio production techniques?	Design and make a new school bag, PE bag, lunch bag or pencil case. Put your sewing skills to the test. Include an appropriate design.

What is similar to ours? What is different?	June 8 th is World Ocean Day. Research the different oceans of the world. On a map, label the oceans and include an interesting fact about each of them.	Create an informative presentation about World Ocean Day. Why do we have it? When did it start? Why is it important? How is it celebrated?	Imagine you are a travel agent and you need to encourage tourists to go to a country of your choice. Create a leaflet promoting this place. Remember to explain how you will get to the location.
