Curriculum Information for Parents

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

This half term, we will be reflecting on how we have grown since starting school in September. We will also be

considering what we are looking forward to as we transition into a new school year. This includes: exploring books about growing and having reflective conversations about what we couldn't do that we can do now. We are continuing in our development of strategies to help resolve conflicts and be able to communicate our own and others' emotions.

Physical Development

<u>Fine motor skills:</u> We will be continuing to practice the correct pencil grip and letter formation, paying attention to where the letters start and which direction they are formed.

<u>Gross motor skills:</u> Using strength, balance, co-ordination, agility, we will be practicing a range of athletic games in preparation for sports day.

Communication and Language

This half term we will focus on talking about the past and future whilst using the correct tense. We will also be expanding our drawing club stories and using story maps to help us re-tell stories.

Understanding of the World

We will be exploring a range of celebrations some of which include: Father's Day, Eid, Disability awareness day. In addition to this, we will be thinking about our past achievements, current achievements and what our future goals are.

Literacy
