Governor News - The Full Governing Board met on Monday 13th May. Governors were pleased to note feedback from monitoring visits, that the preparation of pupils and staff had followed DfE guidance and that the implementation of the SATs for year 6 had been well delivered. Further Governor monitoring visits coincided with County Council visits who were able to confirm that policy and guidance had been complied with fully. Governors were also able to witness SATs papers being collected by courier with no irregularities. All staff had been focused on ensuring that pupils were well prepared and able to give their best. Well done everyone!

We approved the budget for 2024/25 noting that the better-than-expected outturn for 2023/24 created a welcome carry forward for this year. We also discussed the School Improvement Plan and areas where Governor visits and monitoring will be able to add value for the Federation, the SLT and parents as a new SIP is developed for 2024/25.
