Year 1/2 Victorian Day – The children in Year 1/2 enjoyed their Victorian Day on Monday. The children and teachers enjoyed dressing up in Victorian clothes and experiencing what school life would have been like in the Victorian times.



Year 5 Butser Farm – The children had a fantastic time at Butser Ancient Farm on Monday. They immersed themselves in Saxon life, learning about how they lived and how their houses were built. The children then became archaeologists, using tools and their deduction skills to work out what items they found during their archaeological dig. They worked out what they thought the fragment was, what it was made from and how it might have been used. Using all these clues, they enquired about what we now know about the people who used the fragment. Using archaeological evidence, the children practiced creating and sewing runes and carving chalk using similar methods that the Anglo-Saxons would have used. A big thank you to our helpers that helped on the trip.
