# **Fryern Funtasia**

On Monday 1st May Fryern Funtasia will be held on the Fryern recreation ground.

At around 12 noon there will be the crowning of the May King & Queen, followed by some wonderful Maypole Dancing by Year 3 and a performance from our fantastic Junior School choir. Hopefully the weather will be kind and the event will be a huge success, just like previous years. We look forward to seeing you all there. If your child is performing in the choir or Maypole dancing, please arrive at the recreation ground shortly before 12noon and meet by the main arena.

## **Absences & Holidays**

- The school is unable to approve any leave for holidays/day trips/time off etc. These missed sessions will be recorded as unauthorised.
- If your child cannot make it in to school due to illness or a medical appointment you must phone the school office by 9.30am.
- Children arriving any time after 9.10am due to lateness will automatically be marked as an unauthorised absence for the entire morning session.

Please be aware that if your child has 10 or more unauthorised sessions (morning = 1 session, afternoon = 1 session) over a 100 day period, Hampshire County Council will serve you with a fine. The penalty will be £60 per child, and will be served separately to each parent. Once the fine is in motion it cannot be reversed. Fines will only be issued from the term after your child turns 5 years old.

### Choir

On Monday 22<sup>nd</sup> May the Junior Choir will be performing for their parents. Children will rehearse as usual straight after school and the concert will start at 4.30pm. All children will need to be collected at 5.15pm if parents are unable to make it to the concert.

### **Year 1 Topic Launch**

On Monday 24<sup>th</sup> April Year 1 will be launching their new topic 'Cracking Castles'. Children can come dressed as someone from a castle in the past e.g. King, Queen, Prince, servant, maid, Knight, Lord, Priest, stable hand, court entertainer etc. During the day we will be role playing different jobs within a castle and what these jobs entailed.
