What time should I drop off /pick up my child at a

Our hours are 9am - 4pm. We also offer an early drop off time of 8am and a late pick up time of 5pm. You can select this option when booking.

What should my child bring? Your child is more than welcome to bring outdoor activity shoes i.e. football boots, but trainers are activity snoes i.e. rootbat boots, but trainers are essential in case we need to go inside. We will provide all necessary equipment for all the sports and activities your child will take part in.

Only children who are eligible and book onto the 360 Sports (HAF) camps will receive breakfast and lunch. For all other bookings, please provide your child with healthy snacks, a packed lunch and a refillable drinks bottle – no fizzy drinks. We operate a NO NUT policy on our camps so please do not pack

Will you provide drinks?
Yes. All of our camps will have access to drinking water to refill water bottles.

No, we are unable to apply sunscreen to children. Please ensure your child arrives wearing the appropriate factor and send additional sunscreen in with your child. We will remind them throughout the day to apply it.

We have inside facilities available all week.

What if my child doesn't enjoy it? Trust us, they will. However, please do feel free to raise this with us and we will deal with individual circumstances

All of our coaches are First Aid trained. If there is an emergency, you will be contacted immediately on the emergency contact details you have provided.

What should my child wear? Every child should wear appropriate clothing for

outdoor activities, tracksuits with shorts if the weather is good and a waterproof jacket.
