Curriculum Information for Parents

Year 2 - Summer Term 1 2023

English

Children will be writing an alternative version of a popular fairy-tale linked to our growing topic. They will also be writing an information text on plants.

In our guided reading we will continue to focus on developing our understanding of what we have read. We will explore different vocabulary choices and discuss how this affects meaning.

Maths

Our daily maths sessions and mental maths this half term will include the small steps for fractions:

- An introduction to parts and whole.
- Equal and unequal parts.
- Recognise and find a half, a quarter and a third.
- Find the whole.
- Unit and non-unit fractions.
- Recognise the equivalence of a half and two quarters.
- Recognise and find three-quarters.
- Count in fractions up to a whole.

We will be teaching our time unit. The small steps for this unit are:

- Tell the time to the o'clock, half past, quarter past, quarter to and in 5 minute intervals.
- Find the minutes in an hour and hours in a day. We will be teaching our statistics unit. The small steps for this unit are:
- Make tally charts, tables and block diagrams.
- Draw and interpret pictograms (in 1's, 2's, 5's and 10's).

- Maths We are continuing to recall our 2,5 and 10 times table. Please also encourage your child to know the division facts too. We will be sending home your Times Tables Rockstars login soon!

Our learning during this unit will include.... Science

This term we will observe and describe how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants. We will find out and describe how plants need water, light and a suitable temperature to grow and stay healthy.

We are very excited to have Computer Xplorers coming back in to enhance our computing curriculum this term.
