<u>Curriculum Information for Parents</u> <u>Year 6 – Summer Term 1 2022</u>

English

In English, we will be writing a first person description and finally, much to year six excitement, we will be studying gothic horror including Dracula and Frankenstein!

In guided reading, we will be analysing a range of fiction, non-fiction and poetic extracts and applying our inference, retrieval and clarification skills to answer questions about these texts. We will be looking at our test technique and developing our skills ready for the test.

Maths

Our daily maths sessions this half term will be learning about shape, angles, statistics and reasoning through problem solving. We will also be revising and embedding our knowledge of calculation in number, fractions and percentages and using these strategies to problem solve and reason.

Little and often is best! Please support your children with revision so that their confidence is built and any anxieties about 'wobbly topics' are hopefully alleviated!

Our learning during this unit will include....

<u>History –</u> We will learning about the British Empire and its history and impact.

<u>Computing</u> – This half term in computing, we will be learning how coding can be used to control a microbit.

<u>PE</u> –During our outdoor PE sessions, we will be learning bowling, batting and fielding skills for the game of cricket. We will also be learning skills for a range of athletics activities.

<u>DT-</u> This half term we will be using our cooking skills linked to last half terms geography unit of climate change. The children will be making sustainable choices with food, designing and making vegan pizzas.

<u>RE</u> – This half term, we will be studying the concept of pilgrimage and the importance of this to some religions.

Spanish — We are very lucky to be continuing our Spanish learning with Mrs McCormick. This half term we will be learning a range of Spanish adjectives. This learning will then be built into sentence work.
